# Information

## Parking

There will be **no available onsite parking** for exhibitors and delegates attending Meet the Buyer National 2025. There is a free of charge Park & Ride located at <u>Ingliston Park & Ride</u>. From there, you can travel by tram directly to the venue. A **tram discount code** has been created for the event. Please see further information under the 'Tram' section of this page.

Disabled parking is available at the venue for blue badge holders, badges should be visible for parking stewards.

### Travel

#### Rail

**Waverley Station** is Edinburgh's main railway station and the second biggest in Scotland, with services from all over Scotland the rest of the UK. It is situated right in the heart of the city and is a short bus, tram or taxi ride from Murrayfield Stadium.

#### Bus

Lothian Buses run several routes throughout the city that service Murrayfield Stadium.

- from Edinburgh City Centre -Services 1, 3, 12, 22, 25, 26, 30, 31 or 33.
- from Edinburgh Airport Airlink 100 to Murrayfield Stadium and the City Centre.
- from Ingliston Park and Ride -Service X12.
- The Scottish Citylink 900 Service from Glasgow will stop on Corstorphine Road, on the north side of Murrayfield Stadium.

#### Tram

Edinburgh Trams fast, run а frequent service to the entrance of Murrayfield Stadium from Edinburgh Airport, Ingliston Park & Ride, Edinburgh Gateway, Edinburgh Park Station, Haymarket Station and St Andrew Square tram stop, just a short walk from Waverley Station. Tickets must be purchased before boarding trams: www.edinburghtrams.com



#### **Venue Access**

Ramps & Lifts: Step-free access is available throughout the venue. Lifts connect all main floors, including the conference and exhibition suite level. If you require lift access upon arrival, please member speak to of the а Speakeasy Event Team who will direct you to the nearest lift.

**Accessible Toilets:** There are accessible toilet facilities available on all floors near the conference and exhibition suites.

**Guide Dogs:** Guide and assistance dogs are welcome throughout the venue.

# **Hearing Support**

**Closed Loop Hearing System:** A portable closed loop system will be available at the front of the main presentation area. If you wish to use this, please sit in the reserved front-row seats, as the system only functions effectively in this area.

**Wireless Headphones:** A selection of wireless headphones will be available for attendees who are hard of hearing. These can be collected at the entrance to the presentation area and returned after use.

# Registration & Event Support

Accessible Registration: If you have a mobility issue, please speak to a member of the Speakeasy Event Team when you arrive. You will be directed to an accessible registration desk and assisted to the conference and exhibition area. There is no need to queue.

**Reserved Seating:** Reserved frontrow seats in the presentation area are available for those using hearing support devices or requiring easier access.



### **Session Recordings**

Recordings of the sessions will be available post event and will include subtitles. Subtitles will not be available during live sessions.

The sessions will be live on the day, so there will be no access to event materials prior to the event.

### Sensory-Friendly Options

**Sensory-Friendly Hour:** If you are seeking a more sensory-friendly experience, the final hour of the event (2:30pm to 3:30pm) is expected to be quieter, with smaller crowds and reduced noise levels.

**Quiet Space:** If you require a quiet room during the event, please visit the venue reception. Availability is subject to room availability on the day. There are also seating areas available in the public concourse should you need a place to rest.
