Event Accessibility


Please ensure you noted any accessibility requirements on your registration form. If you have not, please contact mtb@speak.co.uk as soon as possible.

Fast Track Badges



Fast Track Entry & Event Check In

You can skip the registration queue completely by using the Check-In function on the Event App. When you arrive at the event with your pre-printed Fast Track Badge and the Event App downloaded.



When you click this icon you will be asked to scan a QR Code to check-in for the event. These QR codes will be available around the venue entrance and at reception. Press 'Scan Now' at the bottom of your screen to proceed to the Event Check-In.



Getting to the Event

The Music Hall is located at Union Street, Aberdeen, AB10 1QS | View Location Map

The Music Hall is located conveniently on Union Street in the heart of Aberdeen City, within a few minutes walk from the bus and train stations.



Aberdeen Train Station is a 5 minute walk from the Music Hall.

Please ensure that you check with your rail network provider to find out if your train will stop at Aberdeen Station.

For more information on the rail network within the UK, please visit **Scotrail**, **East Coast**, **National Rail** or **Trainline**; a one-stop shop for train and coach travel.



The bus station has two entrances, Guild Street and Market Street. The station is connected to Union Square which itself is connected to the railway station.

Bus stops near Music Hall:

- Bridge Street 3 min walk
- Crown Terrace 5 min walk
- Union Terrace Gardens 4 min walk
- St Nicholas Kirk 4 min walk





The Music Hall is located in the heart of the city and within 10km (6 miles) of Aberdeen Airport.


