

Overview

The Islands Growth Deal is a 10-year package of investment that will seek to drive economic growth and the creation of sustainable jobs across Shetland, Orkney and Na h-Eileanan Siar (the Outer Hebrides).

Jointly funded by the UK and Scottish Government, it will see investment in 16 projects and programmes across three strategic themes: low carbon, supporting growth/ future industries, and thriving sustainable communities.

The deal aims to deliver up to 1,300 jobs across the three island groups by 2032, to improve economic productivity, and to support the islands in becoming one of the first places in the UK to achieve net zero.

The Supplier Development Programme has published an online report on the Islands Growth Deal webinar that took place on 5 March 2024, at 2pm. Alongside the Supplier Development Programme, Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (the Outer Hebrides Council) Orkney Islands Council and Shetland Islands Council partnered this event.

This event gave suppliers an overview of the opportunities in the 10-year pipeline of work (with £33.3m being invested within each island group) and covered a number of sectors supported through the Islands Growth Deal including:

- Aerospace
- Economic Infrastructure, renewables, green energy and ports
- Food and Drink
- Energy, Circular Economy and Environment
- Tourism

Supplier Registration and Attendance

In total, 107 suppliers pre-registered interest in the Islands Growth Deal webinar. There were 67 actual attendees on the day. Those attendees represented 46 Scottish SME unique businesses. 41 of those SMEs in attendance were from businesses in the Islands Growth Deal area, with 19 from Na h-Eileanan Siar, 17 from Shetland and 5 from Orkney.

Supplier Survey Feedback

An online survey was distributed to Islands Growth Deal webinar attendees. The survey was live from 5 March – 9 April 2024. 24 responses were received.

The survey highlighted

- 92% of those who replied said they would recommend the webinar to others.
- 88% of respondents rated the webinar as 'excellent' or 'good'.
- 87% said (following the webinar) they felt more positive about potentially working with the public sector buyers involved in the webinar.
- 79% felt their bid would be stronger (for associated tenders) after attending the webinar.
- 46% said they were encouraged to consider bidding (for associated tenders) after attending the webinar.


Promotion through the Supplier Development Programme

Social Media Analysis

Prior to the event, SDP published 10 posts, across Facebook, LinkedIn, and Twitter, promoting the Islands Growth Deal webinar. The campaign ran from 5 to 29

February 2024. Collectively, the posts earned 2,844 impressions (the number of times users saw a post) and 70 engagements (the number of times users interacted with posts). In total, there were 15 clicks on the links embedded in these posts.

Newsletters/Mailings

The Islands Growth Deal webinar was announced in the February 2024 edition of the SDP monthly newsletter.

• 27 February newsletter received 18 clicks to the webinar page.

SDP also utilised a targeted approach to email marketing, sending out 2 solus emails about the event, to all suppliers based in the Islands Growth Deal regions.

- 8 February solus email received 27 clicks to the webinar event page.
- 4 March solus email received 11 clicks to the webinar event page.
