The Air Commodities Team, part of the UK Ministry of Defence (MoD), intends to extend ACComm2/7040 with L'Hotellier for The Provision of a Support Contract for Spares Provision, Repair and Core Ad-hoc PDS until 31.1.2021. As a part of this extension the Authority intends to uplift the current contractual value up to approximately 7 900 000 GBP

It is considered that this extension can be placed using the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice pursuant to Article 28(1)(e) of Directive 2009/81/EC (Regulation 16(1)(a)(ii) of the Defence and Security Public Contracts Regulations (DSPCR) of 2011). This is due to a technical impracticality for another economic operator to undertake the work required within this contract. L'Hotellier hold patents, manufacturing information and technical expertise necessary to provide the required services. No other supplier will be able to provide said services within the timescales required and meet the MOD's MAA standards. To contract with another supplier would create an unacceptable safety risk for the MOD.
