The Defence Equipment and Support (DE&S) Underwater Electronic Warfare (UEW) Delivery Team (DT) is considering a 10 year in service support contract including spares availability and technology refresh on some of the equipments for Miscellaneous Sonar Equipment (MSE). Expected start date would be April 2021. The total value of the contract is expected to range from 20 000 000 GBP — 28 000 000 GBP. MSE includes Echo Sounders, Underwater Telephones, Towed Noise Sources, and some additional Minor Sonars. The portfolio includes safety related sonars.

The detailed technical information and support requirement will be released with the tender documents and will be classified as Official – Sensitive.
