Every day, Viridor takes what British homes and businesses throw away and transforms it into essential quality materials, resources and energy for customers across the UK and globally.

Viridor works in partnership with over 150 local authorities including 96% of Scottish councils. It supports public bodies, Scottish universities and colleges and supports Scotland's leading businesses including Scottish Power, RBS, BAE Systems and Coca Cola Enterprises.

The company is investing £1.5bn in vital low carbon infrastructure and has the UK's largest network of 327 advanced recycling, energy recovery and landfill diversion facilities.

TRANSFORMING WASTE IN CLYDE VALLEY

VIRIDOR IS WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CLYDE VALLEY RESIDUAL WASTE PROJECT, A GROUP OF AUTHORITIES COMPRISING EAST DUNBARTONSHIRE, EAST RENFREWSHIRE, NORTH AYRSHIRE, NORTH LANARKSHIRE AND RENFREWSHIRE COUNCILS TO TRANSFORM POST-RECYCLING, RESIDUAL WASTE.



Viridor will design, construct, finance and operate new, state-of-the-art facilities to treat waste which would otherwise go to landfill.



Viridor will transport each council's collected waste to a new, purpose built facility at Bargeddie, North Lanarkshire. There recyclable material will be removed from the waste to prepare a refuse derived fuel which will be transported to Viridor's Energy Recovery Facility at Dunbar, East Lothian – diverting 90% of waste from landfill.



Viridor will process approximately 190,000 tonnes of residual waste per year providing essential services to a population of more than 845,000 people, helping reach national targets for recycling and landfill diversion by 2025.



SUPPLY CHAIN OPPORTUNITIES

The project will deliver a broad range of opportunities for small business and social enterprises – from providing services direct to Viridor over a twenty-five year period, to working with our construction contractor or sub-contractors.



BARGEDDIE PRIMARY TREATMENT FACILITY

Viridor will develop a new, purpose built £22m primary treatment facility at Bargeddie, North Lanarkshire. There recyclable material will be removed from the waste to prepare a refuse derived fuel which will be transported to Viridor's Energy Recovery Facility at Dunbar, East Lothian.

CONSTRUCTION OF VIRIDOR'S £177M DUNBAR ENERGY RECOVERY FACILITY (ERF) COMMENCED IN 2014.



The facility is integral to the Scottish Government's ambitions to deliver a zero waste, circular economy which encourages waste reduction, boosts recycling and recovers vital renewable energy from what remains. Following a 36 month build programme, the facility is due for completion in December 2017.
